Fayetteville Christian School Hires Three New Varsity Coaches:

Fayetteville Christian School Athletics would like to announce that it has made some major moves involving its coaching staff.



Baseball: The Warriors have hired Austin Fuentes as it's new varsity head baseball coach. Coach Fuentes is a graduate of South view High School where he played varsity baseball for four years under the tutelage of Coach Scott Ellis. While at South View, Coach Fuentes set two school records: stolen bases in a year and stolen bases in a career. Those records still stand. He went on to play college baseball at Methodist University. During his senior year at Methodist, Coach Fuentes became the Head Coach of Pine Forest High School's JV team. Upon his college graduation, Coach Fuentes returned home to Hope Mills, where he teaches at Baldwin Elementary.

For the last three years he has coached the junior varsity team at his alma mater, South View, for three years. With all this, he still coaches travel baseball on the weekends for Athletes Choice Batting Center located in downtown Fayetteville. Coach Fuetnez endeavours to develop a baseball program from middle school up through varsity.
