Phonics/Reading: We focus on letter sounds, blends, and sight words at the beginning of the year. During the second half of the year, we continue to build strong phonetic skills and also begin leveled reading groups. Our goal is to help each student develop a love for reading and to feel confident in their abilities.

Bible: We learn one Bible story and verse each week. The children hear the story from the Bible and learn to apply its meaning to their everyday lives. There is an oral Bible verse quiz every Friday.

Math: We provide many hands-on and group activities to learn our topics throughout the year. We focus on learning about numbers, calendar skills, sorting, graphing, addition, subtraction, telling time, and money.

Spelling: We have weekly spelling tests.

Specials: PE, Music, Library, Chromebooks, and Chapel

Rest Time: We have a daily quiet time in the afternoons for the students as we have such a busy day together. At the beginning of the year, it lasts for one hour, and then it decreases to 45 minutes, 30 minutes, and 15 minutes as they move closer to First Grade.

Centers: The children participate in Literacy, Math, and free centers daily. Each student is encouraged to visit every center during the week.

Assistant: Depending on our classroom enrollment, we will have either a full-time or a part-time teaching assistant.

Interactive classroom: All of our lessons are on the interactive whiteboard. Students can participate and move things on the board. We also have Chromebooks that students are able to use to practice what we are learning.
